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Our Services: Health Information Exchange (HIE) Portal

The Alaska Health Information Exchange (HIE) is a growing network of healthcare providers across the state that allows for real-time, secure sharing of and access to critical patient data such as lab results, radiology reports, encounter histories, and care summaries. Integrated into providers' workflows, the HIE Portal enhances care coordination and improves patient outcomes by ensuring timely and seamless data exchange.

POINT OF CARE

The HIE Portal provides information from across care organizations for point-of-care decision making



CARE COORDINATION

Provider-driven notifications and filters allow efficient coordination of care.



PUBLIC HEALTH DATA UTILITY

Collecting and connecting various information sources helps streamline the process of public health data collection.

MANAGING SENSITIVE DATA

The HIE allows Substance Use Disorders (SUD) providers to securely share 42 CFR Part 2 data with patient consent, improving care coordination while safeguarding privacy.

- Clinical Information
 Encounters, labs, radiology
 reports, care summaries,
 problem lists, immunizations
- Patient Information Demographics, next of kin, contact details
- Clinical Data
 Overdose alerts, inpatient/ outpatient encounters, clinical notes, allergies
- Medication Information Consolidated medication lists and recent prescription information
- Care Coordination Care team details, care programs, care alerts, referral history
- Social Needs Z-code data, reported social issues, housing, socioeconomic factors

Improve patient outcomes
