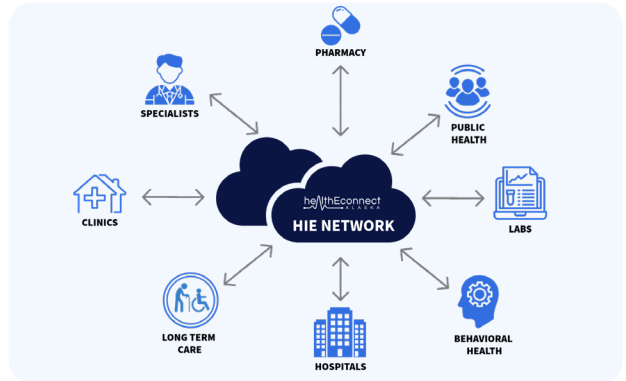
An overview of healthEconnect Alaska, our partners, services, and statewide network.

Alaska's Health Information Exchange

Established in 2009, healthEconnect Alaska is a nonprofit organization designated by the Alaska Department of Health to serve as Alaska's statewide Health Information Exchange (HIE).

Our mission is to improve the health and wellbeing of all Alaskans by securely connecting healthcare information and supporting the timely exchange of data where and when it is needed most.

Today, healthEconnect Alaska works with more than 130 organizations across the state and supports a growing network of providers, hospitals, behavioral health organizations, laboratories, public health programs, and community partners.

Services we Provide



Health Information Exchange (HIE) Portal

Secure access to patient information and care coordination tools through the HIE Portal or directly within participating electronic medical record systems.



Direct Secure Messaging (DSM)

A HIPAA-compliant messaging solution that enables healthcare organizations and care teams to securely exchange protected health information.



Public Health Reporting

Electronic reporting solutions that support public health programs and streamline the exchange of laboratory, immunization, and other reportable data.



Data Solutions

Customized data routing, analytics, reporting, and visualization services that help organizations make better use of healthcare data.

Our Network

healthEconnect Alaska's network includes more than 130 participating organizations and over 850,000 patient records. Participants include:
